In the spirit of reading local, the Carver County Library has a Local Author Collection in order to showcase the emerging literary efforts of our community. This collection will introduce library users to homegrown talent that is not yet nationally known, and give local authors a way to connect with their audiences. Local residents of all ages are encouraged to submit their books for consideration. Materials will be selected based on the guidelines below.

Submission Guidelines

- Author must be a current resident of Carver County or the Carver County Library service area.
- Book submissions must be professionally printed, bound, and in physical condition suitable for circulation.
- Submissions must be donated to the library and will become the property of the Carver County Library.
- The collection is intended to contribute to the education and enjoyment of the community. Criteria for selection generally follow the Carver County Library Collection Development Policy*.
- Materials that are accepted and added to the collection will be subject to the same standards as any other library material and may be reconsidered, weeded, and withdrawn in the course of time.
- Materials that are not accepted for addition into the Library's collection will be handled in accordance with the Carver County Library Donations Policy* and the Collection Development Policy*. No items can be held for or returned to individuals.
