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Carver County Library programs reflect the mission that “to best serve the Carver County community, the library will be a provider of resources, spaces, and experiences that enrich and empower people’s lives”.

Library programs provide information, education, and recreation responding to the needs and interests of people of all ages, families, groups and local communities. Programs and events are planned to promote library resources and services, literacy, the arts, and lifelong learning. The Summer Reading Program, public computer classes, and the exhibition of quality artwork in Library spaces are examples of Library programming. Partnerships are encouraged to enhance the program experience and reach out to new and diverse customers. The Library follows the Carver County Art policy and the Library Bill of Rights (LB 18) in Library program selection.

Individuals may request reconsideration of a Library program by submitting a written request for reconsideration form, *Request for Reconsideration of Program*. This form is available at all library locations and on the Library’s website. The Library Director will respond in writing to the individual’s request. The Carver County Library Board, upon request, hears appeals of the Director’s written response. The final decision on appeals rest with the Carver County Library Board.
