Application Information

- Volunteers must be age 13-18 or attending high school in the fall of 2026.
- Application, training, and orientation are required. Youth age 18 will require a background check.
- **Applications must be received by April 24, 2026.** Applications received after the deadline we cannot guarantee will be processed.
- Acceptance of an application is at the library's discretion; completing an application does not guarantee an available position. Priority is given to returning volunteers and Carver County residents.

Teen Volunteer Description

- Teen volunteers help staff with our annual summer reading program June-August.
- Tasks for teen volunteers include shelving, preparing materials, helping at library programs, and other library related projects.
- Norwood Young America Library asks for a commitment of a total of 10-15 hours over the summer, arranged in one weekly 2 hour shift. Shift schedules will be sent out by email.
- Additional optional opportunities for volunteering may be available both in the summer and the following school year.

Interview

- Volunteers will be interviewed and are selected based on their qualifications in relation to the needs of the library at any given time. Interviews will occur in **May**.

Training and Orientation

- Volunteers will complete online training by the county.
- All volunteers **MUST** attend a three hour orientation session at Norwood Young America Library. Staff will work to schedule this with volunteers. You will **not** be able to volunteer until your orientation is completed.

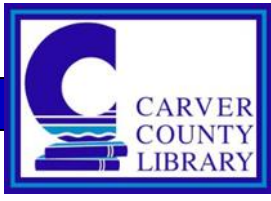
